## T3 EXPERIENCE

### PRE-WORK

- Assemble an interprofessional T3 training team (3+ people; 2+ professions) and begin project planning
- Complete readings and team activities

### 3.5-DAY PROGRAM

**PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT:** Learn skills to address conflict, minimize implicit bias, coach team members, present research-based evidence for IPE to stakeholders, conduct high-quality research, and support scholarship throughout your IP project

**TEAM DYNAMICS:** Discuss hierarchy, practice facilitation skills, create team agreements, and learn about team members' personal and working styles

**IP CURRICULAR DESIGN:** Review IP theoretical frameworks, apply curricular planning tools to your project, and learn new interactive teaching strategies

**IP ASSESSMENT & EVALUATION:** Ground your project in IP theories and research frameworks and make plans to collect data and feedback for publication and for iterative improvements

**PROJECT MANAGEMENT:** Get your project off to the right start with essential project planning documents

**LEADING CHANGE:** Prepare to implement projects at home institutions and take key steps to ensure project sustainability
